EXPLANATORY NOTE FOR THE PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO CUESPORTS SINGAPORE'S CONSTITUTION

In line with Sports Singapore's ("SSG") aim in getting the various National Sports Associations ("NSA") to align their Constitutions with the new Model Constitution ("MC"), Cuesports Singapore has proposed some changes to our current Constitution to align with the MC. This set of proposed amendments have been approved by SSG. A copy of the existing Constitution can be viewed on the website of Cuesports Singapore.

We highlight below the salient proposed amendments, for Full Members' consideration:
