



NATIONAL WOMEN 6 RED SNOOKER RANKING RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ENTRIES

- 1.1. The tournament is only open to Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents of Singapore.
- 1.2. Participants must sign up by the closing of entry date. Any entry after the closing date will not be accepted.
- 1.3. Participants are to pay the entry fee upon submission of entry. If entry fee is not received by the draw date, the entry will not be accepted. Cuesports Singapore reserve the rights to not draw your name for the tournament.
- 1.4. For clubs, an undertaking letter (provided on the Tournament page in Cuesports Singapore Website) must be sent to Cuesports Singapore before the closing date.
- 1.5. Entry fees for tournaments will be as follows:

3. TOURNAMENT VENUE

- 3.1. The tournament will be played at **Lagoon Billiard Room located at SAFRA Toa Payoh, #02-05.**

4. GAME RULES

- 4.1. The tournament will be played by the rules laid down by the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association.
- 4.2. There will be no more than five consecutive FOUL AND A MISS calls, if the offender is requested to play again from the original position..
- 4.3. After the fourth consecutive FOUL AND A MISS call, the referee shall warn the offending player that should a FOUL AND A MISS be called again the non-offender may:
- 4.3.1. Play from where the balls have come to rest; or
 - 4.3.2. Ask their opponent to play from where the balls have come to rest; or
 - 4.3.3. Play the cue-ball from any position on the playing area, unless any player needed penalty points before, or as a result of the last stroke being played. If this option is chosen, Section 3 Rule 12 shall not apply. (Free Ball option does not apply)
- 4.4. If, after a FOUL AND A MISS call, the offender is requested to play from the position left, the previous Foul and a Miss sequence ends.
- 4.5. After potting a Red, or a free ball nominated as a Red, the striker must not leave their opponent snookered behind the nominated colour.

Note: In the absence of a 1-1 referee, the opponent must warn the offending player after the fourth consecutive FOUL AND A MISS call. Otherwise, it shall not be considered the fourth consecutive FOUL AND A MISS call.

5. FORMAT

5.1. Straight Knock-out format

5.3. If there are less than 16 entries for the categories by the closing date, Cuesports Singapore shall reserve the right to cancel the tournament.

6. DRESS CODE

6.1. Preliminary Rounds - Semi Final

- Long sleeve plain formal shirt
- Black formal business pants
- Black formal leather shoes

6.2. Grand Final

- Long sleeve plain formal shirt
- Black formal business pants
- Black formal leather shoes
- Bow tie and Vest

6.3. Players who are not properly attired will be issued a penalty of 1 frame immediately.

7. SCHEDULE

7.1. The schedule for the tournament is as follows:

7.2. Fixtures / results can be found on Cuesports Singapore's Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/CuesportsSingapore/>) and tournament venue after the date of publication of draw.

7.3. Players shall be solely responsible for monitoring their own fixtures and results. The Organizer reserves the right to make any necessary adjustments at its discretion.

7.4. In the event of a scheduling conflict between match times for the Open and Women's categories, the Organizer reserves the right to amend the match timing as deemed appropriate under the circumstances.

7.5. No delays or postponements of matches shall be permitted unless expressly authorized by the Organizer.

8. TOURNAMENT REPORTING PROCEDURE

8.1. All players must report to the Chief referee at the tournament desk **at least 30 minutes before** the scheduled match.

8.2. **15 minutes before**; 5 minutes warm up per player

8.3. **5 minutes before**; Conduct of lag to determine break

8.4. From 2nd session onwards, warm up is subjected to the time allowance after the end of previous match and also reporting time of player.

8.5. Matches on weekdays will be scheduled up to 2 sessions per day starting from 7:30pm.

- 8.6. Matches on weekends will be scheduled up to 4 sessions per day starting from 10:30am.

9. MATCH PROCEDURES

- 9.1. If a player is not present by the commencement time of the match;
- Penalty of 1 frame
 - Not present by 10th minutes, officially recorded as a walkover.
- 9.2. **A player shall concede a walkover, if they are not present at the table within 10 minutes of the scheduled commencement time. No grace period shall be granted.**
- 9.3. Each player will only be allowed to call 1 time-out (7 minutes) during the match. Players who exceed the time limit, a penalty of 1 frame will be conceded to his/her opponent.

10. SLOW PLAY AND 45 SECONDS RULE

- 10.1. **Warning will be given if the overseeing referee deems there is a deliberate slow play.**
- 10.2. Should the player continue her slow play, 1 frame will be awarded to the opponent.
- 10.3. Subsequently, should the player not heed the warnings and continue slow play, the match will be awarded to the opponent.
- 10.4. If the referee thinks a position of stalemate exists, or is being approached, or is indicated by both players, the referee shall offer the players the immediate option of re-starting the frame. If either player objects the referee shall allow play to continue for three more strokes from each player

11. OTHER CONDITIONS

- 11.1. Players are not allowed to smoke in the tournament venue.
- 11.2. Players are not allowed to place any cigarettes or lighters in the seating area.
- 11.3. Players are strictly prohibited from using their mobile phones during their match and must ensure that their devices are switched to silent mode.
- 11.4. Any form of conducting or participating in games of money or gambling is strictly prohibited during the tournament.

12. AUTHORITY

- 12.1. All disputes regarding match referees' decisions may be brought to the attention of the presiding Chief Referee by the players concerned and his decision is final.
- 12.2. All disciplinary matters shall be referred to Cuesports Singapore, whose decision shall be final on all matters arising.
- 12.3. The organiser reserves the right to amend the above set of rules and regulations with prior notification to all participants when it deems necessary. Any matter not covered by the above set of rules and regulations shall be decided by the organiser whose decision shall be final.
- 12.4. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations, even in the absence of a specifically stated penalty, may result in disciplinary action. Such actions will be determined at organizer's sole discretion, and its decisions on these matters shall be final and conclusive.
