1	<b>Welcome Address – President</b>
1.1	<p>At 4:03 pm, five (5) full members were present, meeting the minimum quorum requirement of at least a quarter (1/4) of the voting members (i.e., Full Members) as stipulated in Article 18 of the Constitution.</p> <p>The meeting was called to order by CS President, Mr Christopher Chuah who delivered his welcome address.</p>
1.2	<p>CS President, Mr Christopher Chuah, expressed his appreciation to all members for attending the 2025 CS AGM and conveyed his heartfelt gratitude for their dedication and contributions. He noted that their collective efforts have been instrumental in advancing CS's objectives and shared a report outlining key milestones and achievements over the past two years.</p> <p>Cuesports Singapore has been granted Institution of a Public Character (IPC) status for the period from 15 April 2024 to 15 April 2026. President highlighted the importance of maintaining this status to strengthen fundraising efforts, as it allows donors to benefit from tax deductions. He encouraged members to actively engage potential corporate and foundation sponsors in support of the Cuesports Singapore Academy (CSA) and its athlete development programmes.</p> <p>With strong representation from the current Board, Cuesports Singapore successfully reached an amicable resolution regarding the suspension of its membership with the Asian Confederation of Billiard Sports (ACBS). The suspension was officially lifted on 28 January 2024, following a constructive meeting held in Jakarta on 23 January 2024. Cuesports Singapore is currently working closely with ACBS on athlete participation and the organisation of tournaments in Singapore.</p> <p>Cuesports Singapore Academy (CSA) has played a vital role in nurturing talent and facilitating numerous competitions, training sessions, and community outreach programmes. In November 2024, CSA at Katong Shopping Centre were closed due to the owner's redevelopment plans. With the support of SportSG, Cuesports Singapore successfully secured a new location at 371 Tanjong Katong Road, within the former Canadian International School. A tender for the renovation works has been launched, and updates on its progress will be provided in due course.</p> <p>CS President, Mr Christopher Chuah reported that CS athletes have delivered strong performances in both regional and international competitions. <b>6</b>	<b>Election of Members to Board as according to the CS Constitution</b>


