



# CUESPORTS SG PRESIDENT 9-BALL WOMEN CHALLENGE (July 2026) RULES & REGULATIONS

## 1. ENTRIES

- 1.1. The tournament is only open to Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents of Singapore.
- 1.2. **The tournament is capped at 16 participants and top 4 seeded national women players are excluded.**
- 1.3. If the number of entries falls below 16 participants, Cuesports Singapore reserves the right to cancel the affected category and refund the registration fees.
- 1.4. Participants must sign up by the closing of entry date.
- 1.5. Participants are to pay the entry fee upon submission of entry. If entry fee is not received by the draw date, the entry will not be accepted. Cuesports Singapore reserve the rights to not draw your name for the tournament.
- 1.6. Entry fee for tournaments is SGD\$25.
- 1.7. Table hire is SGD\$12 per hour payable by losers of the match.



## 2. FEE & PAYMENT

- 2.1. Payment of entry fee(s) is to be made only upon confirmation by Cuesports Singapore, which will be sent to the player via their contact details.
- 2.2. Payment method: PayNow

### 3. TOURNAMENT VENUE

The tournament will be held at **the NATIONAL TRAINING CENTRE**  
**Address: 371 Tanjong Katong Singapore 099253.**

### 4. GAME RULES

The tournament will be played under the latest Standardised Rules of the World Pool-Billiard Association (WPA) with an adjustment to the break.

- a. 9 ball on the spot – Players are to break from behind the head string.
- b. Racking: 1-9-2. The other balls shall be racked without purposeful or intentional pattern.
- c. 3 balls rule applies.
- d. On the break if no ball is pocketed, at least four object balls must be driven to one or more rails, else the shot is a foul.
- e. When 1-1 referee is deployed, players are allowed up to 2 checks and request for one re-rack or adjustment to the rack.

### 5. FORMAT

Double Elimination for Group Stage and Knock-out from Semi to Final

- a. Alternate break
- b. Number of Racks

Stage	Format
Group Stage: Winner Brackets	Race to 6
Group Stage: Loser Brackets	Race to 5
Semi Final - Grand Final	Race to 7



## 6. DRESS CODE

### a. Whole Event

- i. Polo T-shirt / collared shirt/blouse
- ii. Pants/jeans
- iii. Covered toes shoes (Sneakers / Sports Shoes / Business Shoe)
- iv. No skirts, no torn jeans, no offensive attire is allowed

b. Players who are not properly attired will be issued a penalty of 1 rack immediately.

## 7. SCHEDULE

a. The schedule for the tournament is as follows:

b. Fixtures / results can be found on Cuesports Singapore's Facebook page (<https://www.facebook.com/CuesportsSingapore/>) and tournament venue after the date of publication of draw.

c. Players shall be solely responsible for monitoring their own fixtures and results. The Organizer reserves the right to make any necessary adjustments at its discretion.

d. No delays or postponements of matches shall be permitted unless expressly authorized by the Organizer.



## 8. TOURNAMENT REPORTING PROCEDURE

- a. All players report to the Chief referee at the tournament desk at least 30 minutes before the scheduled match.
- b. 15 minutes for each player to warm up
- c. Players may conduct the lag to determine break after the warm up session.
- d. From 2nd session onwards, warm up is subjected to the time allowance after the end of previous match and reporting time of player.
- e. Matches on weekends will be scheduled for up to 2 sessions per day.
- f. If a player is not by **15 minutes** after the commencement time of the match will be officially recorded as a walkover.
- g. In the event of a double walkover where two players are required to fill a position in the losers' bracket, the players shall **play a playoff match. The match is limited to one rack.** Winner of the match will fill the position in the loser's bracket.

## 9. SLOW PLAY AND 45 SECONDS RULE

- a) Warning will be given if the overseeing referee deems there is a deliberate slow play.
- b) A shot clock of 45 seconds will be used in 1 - 1 referee matches. When the shot clock reaches 35 seconds, the referee will call "10 seconds" to warn the player.

Failure to execute a shot within 45 seconds will result in a foul shot giving the opponent a ball in hand.



## 10. OTHER CONDITIONS

- a. Players are not allowed to smoke in the tournament area and in the premises of the National Training Centre.
- b. Players are strictly not allowed to place any cigarettes, lighters, electronic cigarettes or vape in the seating area.
- c. Players are strictly prohibited from using their mobile phones during their match and must ensure that their devices are switched to silent mode.
- d. Any form of conducting or participating in games of money or gambling is strictly prohibited during the tournament.

## 11. AUTHORITY

- a. All enquiries or disputes will be referred to the chief referee during the tournament, and his decision will be final.
- b. All disciplinary matters shall be referred to Cuesports Singapore, whose decision shall be final on all matters arising.
- c. The organizer reserves the right to amend the above set of rules and regulations with prior notification to all participants when it deems necessary. Any matter not covered by the above set of rules and regulations shall be decided by the organizer whose decision shall be final.
- d. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations, even in the absence of a specifically stated penalty, may result in disciplinary action. Such actions will be determined at organizer's sole discretion, and its decisions on these matters shall be final and conclusive.
