RULES & REGULATIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY

- 1.1. The tournament is only open to Singapore Citizens and Permanent Residents of Singapore **50 years old and above.**
- 1.2. Participants who are born in 1976 and after are not allowed to participate.
- 1.3. **Top 16** National Ranked will be **EXCLUDED** in this tournament.
- 1.4. This is a first come first serve basis, Participants must sign up by the closing of entry date. **Entry limited to 20 players.**

2. PAYMENT

- 2.1. Entry fee for the tournament is **SGD \$40.**
- 2.2. Table punch of **SGD \$13** per hour.
- 2.3. Payment method;

3. GAME RULES

- 3.1. The tournament will be played by the rules laid down by the World Professional Billiards and Snooker Association.
- 3.2. In the absence of a referee officiating the match, the "foul and a miss" rule will be applied up to a maximum of 2 times.
- 3.3. After the second "foul and miss," the player must attempt to hit the ball to his/her best ability: a deliberate miss will be considered a "foul and miss."
- 3.4. Beyond that, the incoming player shall play from the final rest position of the balls or ask his/her opponent to play the shot.
- 3.5. "Foul and Miss" rule applies when the difference in points is less than or equal to the points remaining on the table. Once points difference is more the points remaining on table, "Foul and Miss" rule shall no longer apply.
- 3.6. For matches presided over by a referee, the referee shall apply the "foul and a miss" rule based on his/her discretion. In such a case, there will not be a limit to the number of times in which the rule may be applied

5. MATCH DATE

5.1. Weekends only from 5th September to 20th September; 10 AM onwards.

6. DRESS CODE

6.1. Acceptable:

- 6.1.1. Pollo Tee / Shirt
- 6.1.2. Jeans / Pants
- 6.1.3. Covered Shoes

6.2. Non-Acceptable:

- 6.2.1. Round neck tee
- 6.2.2. Track Pants / Shorts / Torn Jeans
- 6.2.3. Uncovered Shoes / Crocs
- 6.2.4. Any offensive outfit

6.3. Players who are not wearing the appropriate attire will be given their 1st warning. On the 2nd warning on a different match day, they may be removed from the tournament with no refund of the entry fee.

7. WARM UP

- 7.1. Players are to report 30 minutes before the match is scheduled.
- 7.2. 10 minutes will be given to the players for their warm up.
- 7.3. A coin toss will be used to determine the break.



8. MATCH PROCEDURES

8.1. Players not present by the commencement time of the match

8.1.1. 10 minutes: Penalty of 1 Frame

8.1.2. 20 minutes: Walkover

9. OTHER CONDITIONS

9.1. Players are not allowed to smoke in the tournament venue.

9.2. Players are not allowed to place any cigarettes or lighters in the seating area.

9.3. Players are strictly prohibited from using their mobile phones during their match and must ensure that their devices are switched to silent mode.

9.4. Any form of conducting or participating in games of money or gambling is strictly prohibited during the tournament.

10. AUTHORITY

10.1. All enquiries or disputes will be referred to the Chief Referee (CR) during the tournament. The CR's decision will be final.

10.2. All disciplinary matters shall be referred to Cuesports Singapore, whose decision shall be final on all matters arising.

10.3. Cuesports Singapore reserves the right to amend the above set of rules and regulations without prior notification to all participants when it deems necessary. Any matter not covered by the above set of rules and regulations shall be decided by Cuesports Singapore whose decision shall be final.

10.4. Failure to comply with these rules and regulations, even in the absence of a specifically stated penalty, may result in disciplinary action. Such actions will be determined at Cuesports Singapore's sole discretion, and its decisions on these matters shall be final and conclusive.
